I have never seen such joy at being allowed to get so messy!!!!

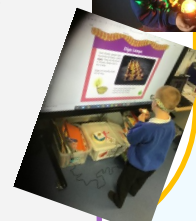
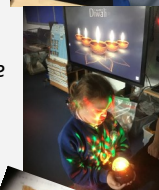
I had the task of picking a winning rangoli design in every class - it was so difficult as all the pupils had tried so hard.

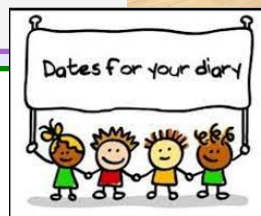

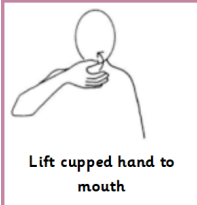

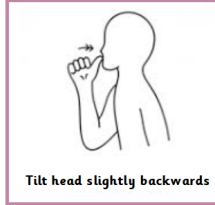


Lift cupped hand to mouth

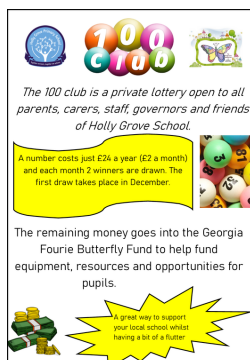
