

Who Is King Charles III?

King Charles III became King in September 2022 after his mother, Queen Elizabeth II died.

> His wife is Camilla, the Queen Consort. After the coronation, she will be known as Queen Camilla.

He has two sons - William, His Royal Highness The Prince of Wales and Harry, The Duke of Sussex.

A coronation is a special ceremony where a new king or queen is crowned.

During the ceremony, the new king or queen has a crown placed upon their head

The new king or queen makes a promise to look after their country.

What Is a Coronation?

King Charles III's coronation day is on Saturday 6th May 2023.

The ceremony will be at a big church in London, called Westminster Abbey.
