Behaviour Leaflet for Parents

The school has an ethos of positive behaviour management — please read this leaflet in conjunction with the school Behaviour Policy on our website.

The school staff are trained in Team Teach positive handling techniques with a strong emphasis on identifying triggers and using de-escalation strategies. We have 4 members of staff who are Team Teach Trainers.

The school has devised its own Behaviour Support Plans for those who require extra help with their behaviour — these plans are shared with all staff/families to ensure a consistent approach. Some children may also require a risk assessment for the safety of themselves and others

When a child joins Holly Grove we will use the first half term to assess their behaviours and the appropriate strategies to use to support them. These will then be put into a Behaviour Support Plan by the Assistant

Headteachers in liaison with home. We have a duty of care to keep our children, staff and resources safe therefore if a child is in crisis and at risk of causing harm, trained staff may use a positive hold to support the child and keep them safe. This will be discussed with parents/carers and added into the child's behaviour support plan.

Classes devise their own rules and pupils are supported / encouraged to adhere to the rules.

Each class works towards their own reward system which helps and encourages pupils to focus on their learning. Some pupils require an individual reward system (Working for) this system is consistently used across school.

At the end of each week during the Friday assembly we celebrate the Holly Grove Heroes of the week. The children are nominated by their class team and are rewarded by sitting on the VIP table on Friday lunchtime and receiving a certificate in assembly.

The Headteacher has prizes in her room which are used as an incentive for children, e.g. to work hard on a new target, toilet training successes, positive behaviour on transport, good behaviour at home etc.

Our Family Support Team and the Class staff are always happy to help if you are having any behaviour problems in the home environment. Please contact school if you feel we can help.
