Obviously as a specialist provision we have some very vulnerable children so we will continue to carry out regular cleaning/hygiene routines and will continue to use our Viro Cube to disinfectant shared rooms on a regular basis (especially if we are informed of a covid case in that room, to try and reduce further contamination).

Can we ask that if your child is unwell they remain at home with you until all symptoms have cleared up. School staff still have access to test kits and will test if they display symptoms and will not come into school if they are positive.
