We loved dressing up as Fire Fighters too!

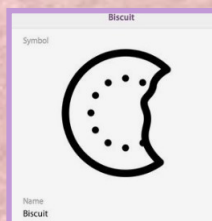
Laura's Class have been very busy in English. It looks like they had a great time learning lots about the story 'Whatever Next'.
