
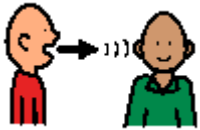


10 golden rules

Talk to me, not about me



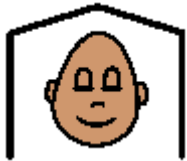
Understand everyone's feelings

Treat me with respect



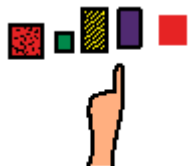
Stay calm with me, even if I do not stay calm with myself
